
1. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Execution of Annual Certificate of Proper Operation for Harris County Flood Control District;
2. Review and approve proposals for the installation of bollards and fence at Woodland Hills Drive and Rankin Road;
3. Authorize attendance at the American Water Works Association Special Districts Summit – Southwest on June 20, 2018 in Austin, Texas;
4. Update on development of recreational amenities, including:
  - a. update on status of Park Bond Application Report for 1<sup>st</sup> Issue of Park Bonds;
  - b. status of Texas Parks & Wildlife Department review of parks and trails grant application, and take any necessary actions on same;
  - c. review and discuss recreational facilities design development packets, and take any necessary actions on same;
  - d. status of preparation of District Parks, Trails and Recreation Facilities Rules & Regulations; and
  - e. hear presentation regarding the Apache Tree Grant Program, and take any necessary actions on same.
