General District Information

Trail of the Lakes Municipal Utility District (the "District") is a Texas local governmental entity that provides water and sanitary sewer service to **Atascocita Forest, The Forest, The Park at Atascocita Forest, Clayton's Park and Clayton's Park East** subdivisions. The District was created on April 26, 1974, by the Texas Water Rights Commission. The District is located 17 miles northeast of downtown Houston and 3.5 miles southeast of Humble, Texas. The District is governed by a five-member Board of Directors who regularly meet the last Monday of each month at 12:00 p.m. at the offices of Radcliffe Bobbitt Adams Polley PLLC, America Tower, 2929 Allen Parkway, Suite 3450, Houston Texas 77019.

Trash Talk: Fall E-Waste Collection

The District will again offer free e-recycling and document shredding in the Fall. Recycling Services

The District provides recycling services to its customers and charges a \$25 non-refundable fee for one (1) recycling bin upon move-in. Please note the following reminders below regarding this service:

- Recycling is collected on Thursdays.
- Please place recycling items in clear or light blue bags before they are placed in the cart. RRRT will not collect recycling items that are placed in black bags.
- Please label any additional recycling receptacle you may utilize for recycling items.
- Garbage will not be collected from a recycling cart.

Greens Bayou Coalition

The District is a proud continuing member of the Greens Bayou Coalition ("GBC"), a 501(c)(3) organization that coordinates with Houston area infrastructure providers and other community stakeholders to improve the quality of life for the approximately 400,000 residents within the Greens Bayou watershed - from Willowbrook to the Houston Ship Channel - through economic development, flood mitigation and parks/trails development. District customers have the opportunity to voluntarily donate to GBC on their monthly water bill to support GBC's economic development programs. If a customer would like to remove the voluntary GBC fee from his/her water bill entirely, please contact Si Environmental, LLC, the District's Operator, at 832/490-1600. If a customer does not wish to make the voluntary GBC donation, but chooses to keep the line item on the bill, the customer may pay exactly \$1.00 less than is shown as the total amount due on the bill.

The District is located within the East Reach of the Greens Bayou watershed. The GBC East Reach committee meetings are generally held on the third Wednesday of each month. To learn more about the GBC and the East Reach meetings, please visit greensbayou.org.

District Parks & Trails Development Update

Development of the District's recreational amenities is underway! The District issued its first series of park bonds in September 2018 to fund the development of Phase I of the District's recreational amenities.

Currently under construction are the following Phase I amenities:

- Lago Forest Drive Playground.
- Walking trail around the perimeter of the Clayton's Park Detention Basin. Along the trail, you will find benches, garbage receptacles and doggie stations for pet clean-up.
- Walking trail around the perimeter of the Atascocita Forest Detention Basin. Along the trail, you will also find benches, garbage receptacles, fitness stations and doggie stations for pet clean-up.
- Fitness Station at the street terminus of Wintergreen Drive.

For the safety of the District's facilities, please refrain from flying drones near the District's Water Plant and Wastewater Treatment Plant facilities. The District and its facilities are located within eight (8) nautical miles of George Bush Intercontinental Airport and therefore a Federal Aviation Administration permit is required to fly drones within such air space.
